We had the opportunity to welcome Bishop Alex and men from around the diocese to a morning of singing, prayer, and meaningful discussion about what Men's Ministry is. The Reverend Tim Surratt, from St. Michael's Church in Charleston, South Carolina, led our discussion and challenged us with some difficult questions. During the morning session, he asked us to consider the differences between trying and training; and which of them leads to the transformation mentioned in Romans 12:2.

What would you say if I asked whether you could run a half marathon with me next week? The answer would likely be no. Let's say the marathon was in 6 months, and you had time to prepare for it. Wouldn't it make sense to train alongside others that could teach you what you needed to know and encourage you through the process?

That's what men's ministry is. It's Christian men training to be better Fathers, Husbands, Sons, and Brothers. It's sharing our experiences, supporting others, and growing in faith. As Paul wrote to Timothy, we must preserve our faith by entrusting it to other faithful men.

The next big event on the calendar is the Gulf Atlantic Diocese Men's Retreat at Camp Anderson, May 5<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>. I suggest you go ahead and mark your calendars today and plan to attend. The program for the retreat is still being designed–if you have suggestions, we would love your input!


