If the heat that's been surrounding us hasn't been warning enough, the active radar off-shore is another reminder that we're in the midst of another hurricane season. As the core captain of the team overseeing our disaster response, I'm happy to report we're in the process of purchasing equipment based on a needs assessment done after an initial interest meeting with those interested in this service.

While we are preparing for future efforts, the need created by past storms is still great today. THERE ARE TWO OPPORTUNITIES TO SERVE ON MISSION TRIPS TO AREAS IMPACTED BY HURRICANES. ONE IS IN FT. MYERS, FLORIDA AND THE OTHER IN GRAND ISLE, LOUISIANA. Both are offered from November 4th to the 11th and the need is great! The cost is \$170 per person for Louisiana and there is no registration fee for Ft. Meyers. However, missionaries must be at least 16 years old for both opportunities.

During these trips, you will be serving the Lord by helping with remodeling projects to rebuild Community Church of Grand Isle or helping with rehabs and new construction in Ft. Meyers. Experience is welcome but not necessary because there's a job for everyone.

Included in the cost is a bunk house or group shelter but there are also limited hotels nearby for an additional cost. There's even a spot to park your RV. Meals are also provided but, of course, attendees are encouraged to lend a hand where needed. It will be a time to serve others, worship together, and help rebuild a community affected by a natural disaster.
