I am an Evangelist, teacher, researcher, and excellent student of both regional and national history of my country.

Putting into practice my training in both theology and community development, my faith and ministry is built on the Gospel as preached by our Lord Jesus Christ in John 10:10, "...I have come that they may have *life, and have it to the full*". The sick should have access to medication and where persons are tormented by satanic powers, they should receive prayer of deliverance; the hungry should be empowered for access to food; the illiterate should have access to both formal and informal education; non-believers should have access to the Word of God; the homeless should be empowered towards access to shelter; to mention but a few.

To achieve better results, the formation of strategic partnerships is high on my agenda as a Bishop. Since my consecration and enthronement as Bishop of South Rwenzori Diocese, the strongest diocesan partner I have engaged with is St. Peter's Cathedral in Tallahassee. I do appreciate the outstanding ministry that you have endlessly offered in terms of reaching out to vulnerable persons in the diocese coupled with supporting some of the day-to-day administration at the diocesan secretariat. Hence, your ministry to South Rwenzori Diocese is amazing. It is my role therefore as the sitting bishop to ensure that our partnership is strengthened and where possible, opportunities to learn from each other are developed and sustained.

May God our Father bless each one of us and give us the long awaited opportunity to see each other during my visit.
