Every year, St. Peter's provides us a way to help others outside our walls through the Advent Trees. This year, the project focuses on supporting at-risk and vulnerable children and youth here in Tallahassee and in the South Rwenzori Diocese in Uganda. Beginning *TODAY, December 3rd*, there will be two trees in the back of the church decorated with ornaments that you can choose from to help a child in need either here or in Uganda.

For many years, St Peter's has provided tuition support to vulnerable children through the ORPHANS AND VULNERABLE CHILDREN (OVC) tuition assistance program in Uganda thanks to generous sponsors, and we now need new sponsors. During our recent trip, we were able to sit down with program administrators and better understand the needs there and streamline administrative processes to make it easier to get information about the sponsored student back to the sponsor and to get letters to the student from the sponsor. On our trip, we had the privilege of meeting and talking with several students currently sponsored. Hearing their goals of becoming engineers, teachers, craftspeople, and even one young man who wants to be a priest was heartwarming. This program supports primary and secondary students on either a vocational or university track.

For the 2024 school year, our goal is to sponsor 100 students, and we are asking for a donation of \$200 per sponsored student. The \$200 represents an average annual cost per student for tuition assistance and administrative expenses, as some students' tuition is higher than others at more advanced school levels. To sponsor a student, please take the ornament with their name and sign your name by the student's name on the sheet.

Locally, you can make Christmas a little brighter for some of the most vulnerable children in our community through the <u>CLEAN START INITIATIVE</u> or support homeless and at-risk youth through <u>CAPITAL CITY YOUTH SERVICES</u>. You will simply choose and sign-up for an ornament with the child's name and wish list, go shopping for the item(s), and bring them back unwrapped but in a gift bag to the Church by December 17th. This is an excellent opportunity for your whole family to get involved in choosing gifts.
