The 40 Days for Life 2022 Spring Campaign in Tallahassee began on *Ash Wednesday, 2 March* and continues through *Palm Sunday, 10 April*. The public prayer vigil is held in the public right-of-way outside the Planned Parenthood facility 12 hours each day from 7am to 7pm, during the 40-day campaign.
