At St. Peter's Anglican Cathedral, catechesis is a vital part of our high school ministry. It is a time of formation when the faith is passed from the parents to the students. This is when the church sees the students become full members. This is such an important time in their lives and in the lives of their families.

To equip these students to make the confirmation vows, we have a catechesis class which focuses on three aspects: (1) Mentorship, (2) Bible Reading, and (3) the Catechism. This is a powerful and formative process that can shape a students imagination of what it means to be a Christian.
