Kairos Prison Ministry 🖁



Kairos Prison Ministry International, Inc. (Kairos) is a Christian faith based ministry that addresses the spiritual needs of incarcerated men, women, youth, and their families. By sharing the love and forgiveness of

Jesus Christ, Kairos changes hearts, transforms lives, and impacts the world. St. Peter's is involved in a multi-denominational team that serves Wakulla Correctional Institution (WCI).

How can you SERVE? Write an encouraging note sharing the hope of Christ to a specific inmate at WCI.

St. Peter's has begun looking at the spiritual needs of those within the communities that surround the Cathedral. To better love our neighbors, we embark upon monthly prayer walks throughout these neighborhoods that are within a two mile radius of the



Church. A group of 3 to 6 walk together to offer encouragement and openly ask people for their prayer needs.

How can you SERVE? Sign up to commit to being part of one monthly prayer walk in the first quarter of 2021 to share the Good News of Christ within our own local community.

Prayer and Fasting for St. Peter's



As the Evangelism & Missions ministry at St. Peter's begins to grow in both enthusiasm and participation, it must be permeated in both prayer and fasting. We are asking God

to raise up a team of parishioners that will continually pray for His work through St. Peter's. Such a team will be asked to both fast and pray for particular needs throughout the year.

How can you SERVE? Sign up to be part of the Evangelism & Missions Prayer Team and commit to a full day of prayer and fasting in the first quarter of 2021.

AWPC educates and supports women facing unplanned pregnancies with compassionate care. They rely on



community support to meet the needs for the families they serve. The Center's "Belly Boutique" contains items families need.

The PHI Center offers services such as pregnancy testing and classes for those who are pregnant and those with young children. They assist parents before and after the birth of their child in obtaining emotional and physical necessities.

How can you SERVE? Sign up to volunteer at one of the many opportunities available at A Woman's Pregnancy Center and PHI Center that range from stocking pantry shelves to facilitating training to offering crisis counseling. There are volunteer opportunities for everyone to share in His love within such work.

How can you GIVE? Purchase baby items for the "Belly Boutique" or purchase clothes, toys, and diapers for the families PHI Center serves.

Miccosukee Hills



Miccosukee Hills is a local apartment complex that houses disabled or elderly residents. We visit the residents for fellowship, prayer, and to assist with small household chores. Watch The Keys for the date of our next visit.

How can you GIVE? Fill a blessing bag with items to brighten the day of a disabled or elderly resident and remind them that Christ loves them.

The A^* rise Ministry offers affirmation and hope to elementary aged school children living in Gretna, Florida. A small after school program offers the love of Christ and a hope for a future with Him.



How can you GIVE? Purchase a gift for a child that will not otherwise receive one at Christmas to encourage their continual participation in an environment where the Gospel is proclaimed.

Uganda Vulnerable Children



The Uganda Vulnerable Children Ministry provides students in the South Rwenzori Diocese with an education. Our students will receive their education at the primary

(elementary), secondary (junior/high school), and university levels. Without financial assistance to pay school fees, these children would not have the opportunity to attend school.
